Minutes of Board of Directors Meeting

Date: November 8, 2014

This emergency meeting of the Board of Directors was held on Saturday, November 8, 2014 at Leftwich Tunnel. Meeting was called to order at 11:30 am by President Linda Fusco. Secretary Anne-Marie Earl agreed to transcribe the minutes.

President's Report:

The Leftwich Tunnel mural artist Darlene McClinton is again over budget for supplies. At the last meeting the board agreed to pay up to \$1500, up from \$1200 originally quoted; and the total to date is \$1628.25. We also ordered the wrong anti-graffiti coating, which we found out would lift the mural from the walls; and the city has recommended we hire someone familiar with the anti-graffiti coatings to apply the one needed. The company that sandblasted and primed the tunnel, Southern Paint and Waterproofing, is able to apply the coating this coming week.

Linda Fusco made a motion for the neighborhood to use up to \$5000 of MSD funds to have the anti-graffiti coating applied by Southern Paint and Waterproofing, as the city recommended. (Their estimate is \$3710.) She also made the motion to pay the full \$1628.25 in materials Darlene McClinton needed to complete the project, which was over the amended \$1500 budget. The board members present unanimously agreed.

The board did a walkthrough of the tunnel to note touch-ups that needed to be done prior to the application of the anti-graffiti coating. The "To Downtown Greensboro" lettering was noted, as well as bringing the green paint out to the sidewalk to cover paint splatters. Some of the paint on the flaps and inside the tunnel has bubbled. The peeling paint needs to be smoothed out. The floor needs touch-ups to the lines around the yellow "brick," and the board noted that the "bricks" look more like cinder blocks than bricks. The board is also requesting trees painted on the Greensboro side flaps.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 11:50 am.
